

Passiflora semiciliosa Planch. & Linden 1873
Subgenus *Passiflora* Super-section *Stipulata* Section
Granadilastrum

Distribution : Colombia and Venezuela.

Plant glabrous throughout; stem terete; stipules semi-ovate, up to 4 cm. long, 2 cm. wide, oblique at base, sharply serrate; petioles bearing several elongate (about 3 mm.), filiform glands; leaves 3-lobed to about 2 cm. from base (lobes linear- or ovate-lanceolate, 6 to 8 cm. long, 1.5 to 2 cm. wide, gradually acuminate, the middle lobe serrate-ciliate, the lateral lobes serrate-ciliate at inner margins); peduncles 20 to 25 cm. long, arcuate above; bracts oblong, about 1.5 cm. long, 1 cm. wide, free to base, glandular-serrate; calyx tube urceolate-tubular, about 1.5 cm. long, 0.8 cm. wide; sepals linear-lanceolate, about 4 cm. long, 0.6 cm. wide, obtuse, aristate dorsally just below apex; petals subequal to sepals; corona filamentose, the filaments 1 to 1.2 cm. long, in 2 series at throat of tube, the third about halfway down; operculum dependent, the margin recurved, fimbriate
