	Princess Maxima of the Netherlands. The female parent (P. 'Blue
	Star') is a hybrid of <i>P</i> . 'Amethyst' and <i>P</i> . subpeltata. The colour of
	the filaments is variable and may be a consequence of light levels
	and/or temperature.
