Parentage	<i>P. mooreana</i> (♀) × <i>P. amethystina</i> (♂)
Description	Flower 7-8cm diameter, scented; petals and sepals pink/lilac; filaments dark purple/white/violet/blue; leaves narrow three-lobed similar to female parent; bracts 2.5cm × 1.5cm; min. temp. 5-10C (0C for short periods). First produced in 2002. The name translates as Harlequin in English. The male parent is the form commonly known as "long peduncle".
