Parentage	<i>P. racemosa</i> (♀) × <i>P. xdecaisneana</i> (♂)
Description	Vine vigorous, green/red, glabrous, four-angled; flower 9-11 cm diameter, unscented; petals dark red; sepals dark red, but lighter and slightly longer than petals; filaments in five series, outer wine-red/purple with three white bands, crinkled to outer edge; bracts 2cm × 1cm; stipules 2-3cm × 1cm; petiole 4-5cm long; six-seven petiole glands mostly paired, sessile; leaves three-lobed 20-25cm long × 20-25cm wide occasionally asymmetric; peduncle 3-5cm; min. temp.10C; dislikes high humidity. The name originates from the colour of the flower, the town of origin and the concept of international solidarity. This hybrid was first produced in 1994, but did not flower for several years.
