Cultivar Name	<i>P.</i> 'Banshee'
Originator	Stefan Lang (Germany)
Parentage	<i>P.</i> 'Byron Beauty' (♀) × <i>P.</i> 'Byron Beauty' (♂)
Description	Flowers fragrant, 8-10cm in diameter; petals and sepals pale pink; outer filaments as wide as petals, reddish-purple and white banded at base, crinkled at apex; bracts 1.5-2cm x 1.5-2cm; leaves three-lobed; recommended minimum temperature 7C; This is a self-fertilised seedling of <i>P.</i> 'Byron Beauty' produced in 1999. The parent plant was believed to be the original (tetraploid) cultivar and not one of the <i>P. incarnata</i> × <i>P. edulis</i> diploid hybrids sometimes labelled as <i>P.</i> 'Byron Beauty'.
