| Description | Vigorous and floriferous; flowers 6cm in diameter; petals white; sepals greenish white on inside surface; corona filaments green at base, purple and white bands to apex; leaves three-lobed, 10cm across; petioles 2cm; 2 petiole glands; peduncles 2cm; minimum temperature unknown, but survived two winters in a cold greenhouse. First flowered in 2003. Shows many features of both parents. Named after a family friend, the late John Crow. |
