	fruits, 2.5 x 2cm, held inside bracts; minimum temperature 7C.
	Both parents are hybrids of <i>P. foetida</i> and <i>P. palmeri</i> var.
	<i>sublanceolata</i> . This cultivar was formerly known as <i>P</i> . 'Pastel
	Pinks'.
