Description	Flowers 8-9cm in diameter, unscented; petals and sepals have different coloration, but both pale pink with darker pink flecks; corona filaments purple and white at apex; leaves three-lobed with soft texture; bracts 6cm x 4cm feathery; self-fertile with deep red fruits, 2.5 x 2cm, held inside bracts; minimum temperature 7C. Both parents are hybrids of <i>P. foetida</i> and <i>P. palmeri</i> var. <i>sublanceolata</i> . This cultivar was formerly known as <i>P.</i> 'Pastel Pinks'.
