Parentage	(Selection of <i>P. tripartita</i> var. <i>mollissima</i> )
Description	Moderately vigorous, floriferous with branching compact habit; flower bell-shaped, pendent, 8-10cm in diameter, unscented; upper surfaces of petals and sepals pale pink with darker pink tinge; calyx tube 9-10cm in length; corona filaments purple ring with white warts; peduncle 2-3cm; leaves 3-7cm, one- and three lobed and occasionally asymmetric two-lobed. Survived -4C. Named after the 1963 film. It differs from normal forms of the species in having smaller leaves, some unlobed, a branching habit and deeper pink coloration in the flowers.
