Description	Flower 7.5cm in diameter, unscented, early flowers with six petals and sepals; sepals and petals purple, deeper in colour than either parent; short sepal awn; corona filaments 6cm in diameter, purple, darker towards centre; bracts 2cm x 1.1cm; leaves three-lobed, 10cm x 12cm; petiole 5cm; four petiole glands; stipules reniform, 4cm x 1.5cm; peduncle 14-16cm. Named after the deep purple wood from <i>Peltogyne</i> sp. used in furniture manufacture. The male parent is the form commonly known as "long peduncle". Minimum temperature 5C.
