Parentage	<i>P. caerulea</i> (♀) × <i>P. × decaisneana</i> (♂)
Description	Flowers 9-10cm in diameter, less fragrant than <i>P. × belotii</i> ; sepals and petals dull red/purple; corona filaments dark purple at centre, banded white/lilac to apex; leaves three-lobed 10-17cm, juvenile leaves unlobed; four petiole glands in two pairs; bracts 3cm x 2cm; peduncle 1.5cm. Minimum temperature 3C, but will tolerate -2C if roots are protected from frost. Named after the wife of the breeder. Although there are several named cultivars with this parentage, this is the first with <i>P. × decaisneana</i> as the male parent. General appearance of vine is close to that of <i>P. × belotii</i> , but flowers similar to <i>P.</i> 'Marijke'.
