Description	Polyploid. Vigorous, floriferous vine; flowers up to 12cm in diameter, lightly scented, reflexing, open several days; styles, androgynophore and anther filaments green with maroon speckling; pollen present; petals broad, pale to deep lilac, occasional white central streaking; sepals broad and fleshy, abaxial surface maroon, green base, claw-like awns, adaxial surface lilac, white central streaking; outer corona filaments 6cm in diameter, banded dark maroon, white and blue to apex; inner corona filaments dark maroon; bracts 1.8cm x 1.4cm; peduncle up to 17cm; glossy dark green leaves up to 14.5cm x 19cm, strong veins, sometimes 3-lobed, usually 5-lobed; petiole 6cm or more; 2-4 petiole glands, 4mm long towards middle of petiole; stipules 4.4cm x 1.3cm; ovoid fruit, green ripening to yellow/orange, up to 6.5cm x 4cm with pungent orange arils. Minimum temperature probably –8°C. Named in honour of breeder's mother, using her maiden name. (Updated 4/09/2006)
