Description	Vine round-stemmed, free-flowering in Autumn. Flowers to 8cm in diameter reflexing, occasionally two at each node; sepals and petals pinkish mauve with 0.5cm sepal awn; peduncle up to 15cm; bracts 0.2cm filiform, irregularly spaced, soon deciduous; outer corona filaments reddish maroon at base banded white and pale violet to apex; leaves three-lobed 12cm wide by 9cm long, sub-coriaceous mid to dark green; petiole to 6cm; two 0.1 cm long petiole glands at mid-point; stipules reniform 1cm x 0.5cm; fruit capsular eight-faceted; fertile pollen. Grown from seed supplied by Mauro Peixoto and named in tribute to his efforts to conserve Brazilian flora.
