Description	Vine glabrous, vigorous; flowers 12cm in diameter, reflexing, no fragrance, peduncles upright 5-6cm; petioles 5-6 cm; leaves three-lobed up to 12cm x 15cm; petals and sepals red, outer corona filaments dark purple at base, white to apex; fruit similar to that of female parent, flavour undetermined. Grown at the San Francisco Botanical Gardens (Strybing) from seed produced by Henk Wouters in 2003. First flowered in September 2005. Flowers, which appear throughout year, are characteristic of male parent, but larger. Foliage resembles female parent. Not thought to be self- fertile, but sets fruit with pollen from other species in Supersection <i>Tacsonia</i> . Tolerates light frosts.
