Parentage	<i>P. parritae</i> (♀) × <i>P. antioquiensis</i> (♂)
Description	Stem round; flowers 17cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals salmon red, wider than purplish red sepals; corona filaments fused in a black ring; floral tube red-green 7cm long; leaves 3-lobed 14cm long; petiole 3cm with 4 minute petiole glands; peduncle 40cm; bracts 2cm. Named after the location in San Francisco, California, where it was first grown.
