Description	Vine glabrous, stem round; flowers 10.5cm in diameter, no fragrance, anthesis at night; petals white; sepals white on adaxial surface, reddish brown on abaxial surface; outer filaments greenish white at base to white at apex; leaves entire, up to 10cm x 6cm; petioles 2-2.5cm with two glands close to leaf base; bracts 2.5cm x 1.5cm; peduncles upright 6-9cm; stipules 2cm x 1.5cm. Flowering period May-November. The name means snow in Japanese.
