Cultivar Name	<b><i>P.</i> 'Nightshift'</b>

Parentage	<i>P. galbana</i> (♀) × <i>P. racemosa</i> (♂)
Description	Stem round; flowers 8cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals and sepals red/purple; corona filaments white, 2cm; leaves entire, 13cm x 15cm; stipules 2.5cm x 1.cm, reddish; bracts 2cm x 1cm; peduncle 2cm; petiole 5cm with two glands close to leaf base. Flowering period at night, June-October. Minimum temperature 10C. Similar to <i>P.</i> 'Kew Gardens', the origin of which is unknown.
