	than sepals; outer corona filaments cream at base light mauve to
	apex, inner corona filaments pink/green; bracts 1.0 x1.5cm dirty
	pink; peduncles 2.0cm; petioles up to 4.0cm with up to 4 glands
	0.2cm long; leaves mostly three-lobed but also polymorphic up
	to 9.0cm x 8.5cm; stipules 2.0cm x 1.2cm reniform; some pollen
	present on anthers. First crossed in 2006, first flowered in 2009.
