Description	Stem round, reddish where exposed; flowers 10-11cm in diameter, unscented; petals 4.5-1.2cm, both surfaces pink; sepals 4.5 x 1.2cm, adaxial surface pink, abaxial surface bears green stripes, slightly keeled with 0.5cm awn; corona filaments consists of one outer row up to 2.6cm long, reddish with white dots, a second white shorter row, irregular, about 0.8cm long, and two short white rows; bracts 1.0 x 0.6cm, 0.5cm below the bud, oblong, serrated, yellowish-green on each side with 1-2 glands; peduncle 6-7cm, green; leaves three-lobed, serrated, 7-8 x 10-12cm; petiole 2-3.5cm, pilose, with one pair of glands at the mid-point; stipules filamentous, serrated, 0.6 cm. The plant was tested for several years and overwintered at 7C. Flowering period July to October. Named after the wife of the breeder. This description was provided by Axel Frank.
