Parentage	<i>P. racemosa</i> (♀) × <i>P. mucronata</i> (♂)
Description	Stem terete, stout, glabrous; flowers 8-9cm in diameter; sepals white tinted pale pink inside, pale pink underside keeled with a strong sepal awn; petals white both sides; corona filaments in two series, outer white, fleshy 1.0-1.2cm long, inner white fine filaments 0.3-0.4cm long; leaves coriaceous, glabrous, pea-green, simple 11-13cm long x 4-5cm wide or deeply three-lobed 8-11cm long x 9-11 wide; petiole 2-3.5cm with two rudimentary glands one third the distance from the leaf blade. Minimum temperature 0C. This hybrid was created to investigate the parentage of <i>P.</i> 'Kew Gardens' [see <i>Passiflorunde</i> 15(1), 2-4, 2007]; it is the reciprocal cross of <i>P.</i> 'Murac'.
