Description	Stem round; flowers 8cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals and sepals pink; outer corona filaments purple/white banded; leaves three-lobed 8cm long x 10cm wide, margin entire; petiole 3cm with two small deciduous glands; peduncle 4cm; bracts 1.2cm x 1.5cm. Flowering period June to October. First flowered in 2009. Minimum temperature 0C. Name refers to the 'capricious' filaments.
