Description	Stem round; flowers 10cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals and sepals magenta/deep pink; outer corona filaments short, blue/white banded; leaves three-lobed 7cm long x 8.5cm wide, margin entire; petiole 3cm with two small asymmetric glands; peduncle 8cm; bracts small, deciduous. Flowering period June to October. First flowered in 2009. Minimum temperature 10C. Name refers to a nymph in Greek mythology.
