Description	Stem round; flowers 11.5cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals and sepals purple; outer corona filaments dark purple at base, white/blue banded to apex; leaves five-lobed 15cm long x18cm wide, margin entire; petiole 4.5cm with two asymmetric glands; peduncle 13cm; bracts 2cm x 1.2cm. Flowering period June to October. First flowered in 2010. Minimum temperature 0C. Name refers to a nymph in Greek mythology.
