Parentage	<i>P.</i> 'White Wedding' (♀) × <i>P. loefgrenii</i> 'Iporanga' (♂)
Description	Stem round; flowers up to 14cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals pale violet/blue; sepals white/pale violet; corona filaments outer two series 4 - 5 cm in diameter, banded pale blue/violet, white/blue to apex, colour variable depending on the light, temperature and day length; leaves 3- and 5-lobed, up to 15cm; bracts 4.5 x 2.5cm; stipules 3 x 2cm; peduncle 15 - 17cm; petiole 6 - 8cm with 2 to 5 glands. Flowering period May to October. Minimum temperature 0°C. Named in honour of the botanist Alwin Berger (1871 – 1931), curator of the Giardini Botanici Hanbury.
