Description	Stem round; flowers 9-10cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals and sepals pinkish-purple; corona filaments dark purple at base, blue at apex; leaves mostly 3-lobed, 8-12cm long; bracts 1-2cm; stipules 2-3cm; peduncle 7-12cm; petiole 2-4cm with 2-4 glands. Flowering period mainly July - November, but sporadically throughout the year. Minimum temperature at least -6°C. Name derives from Greek mythology.
