| Description | Stem round; flowers 7-9cm in diameter, no fragrance; petals and sepals pinkish-purple; corona filaments dark purple at base, purple/blue bands to apex; leaves 3- and 5-lobed, 8-10cm long; bracts 2cm; stipules 2-3cm; peduncle 4-6cm; petiole 2-3cm with 2-6 glands. Flowering period mainly August - November, but sporadically throughout the year. Minimum temperature at least -6°C. Name derives from a Roman god. The male parent is an unnamed hybrid. |
